The International Programme Committee (IPC) has set the following thresholds for accepting a proposal for the EARLI 2023 conference:

Score	Review Decision
35 % or less	Automatic rejection for all contributions, including symposia.
75 % or more	Automatic acceptance for all contributions. Symposia are automatically accepted when both the symposium as a whole as well as the individual papers score 70 % or more.
36 % - 74 %	Review thresholds determined by the EARLI Executive Committee.*

Please note that all scores refer to "combined review scores" (average of review scores).

Whenever there is a discrepancy of more than 25 % between two review scores, for those proposals with an overall score between 36 % - 74 %, the proposal is automatically sent to a third reviewer. The review scores are averaged and taken into account when deciding if a proposal is accepted or not.

Review thresholds for submissions falling outside of the thresholds for automatic acceptance / rejection:

- Symposia with an overall score of 75 % or more are accepted.
- Single Papers scoring 65 % or more are accepted.
- Single Papers scoring 60 % 64 % are accepted as a Poster.
- Posters, Roundtables, ICT Demonstrations and Workshops scoring 60 % or more are accepted.

Symposia with an overall score below 75 % are split into papers.

When a symposium is split, the individual papers comprising the symposium are evaluated on their own merit, according to the acceptance thresholds for Single Papers.

Anything scoring 59 % or less is rejected.
