

EARLI Outstanding Publication Award

An EARLI Outstanding Publication Award is given at each biannual EARLI conference to recognise outstanding work in the field of Learning and Instruction.

Call for nominations

Nominations will be called biannually by the mailing list

All members of EARLI are invited to nominate articles published in european and international journals in one of the two years preceding the 14th Biennial Conference Exeter, England (2011), for the Outstanding Publication Award.

Deadline

Nominations must be received by March 31 2011

Eligibility

Members nominating a particular article should ensure that the article fits the following criteria:

- articles must have been published in European and International journals in one of the two years preceding the Conference;
- Authors of these articles must have been a member of EARLI during those two years;
- The articles must be in the field of Learning and Instruction and have a truly international scope and audience.

Nomination process

1. Nominations should be submitted to earli@ped.kuleuven.be

2. The nomination should include the following materials:

- The Proposal form (attached)
- A digital copy of the proposed article

3. Selection Criteria:

The Scientific Committee will rate the quality of the nominated articles using the following criteria:

- a)** Novelty and innovative value of the MS
- b)** Problem clearly stated
- c)** Contextualization of the work in the appropriate and actual literature
- d)** Recent and relevant literature is referenced
- e)** Quality of presentation
- f)** Quality of the research design and Analysis
- g)** Appropriateness of the interpretation of the results
- h)** Implications for educational practice
- i)** Discussion and critical view of author
- j)** Overall quality

4. Review Process

The review process will proceed in two phases:

- In a first phase each nominated article receives two ratings by 2 independent raters. Articles scoring above the mean of the total of all nominated articles go for a second phase.
- In the second phase the articles are rated by three different and independent committee members. Mean ratings are calculated.

5. Award Scientific Committee

An independent Scientific Committee will rate the quality of all articles:

Chair: An EC member appointed by EC of ERALI

8 Senior EARLI members appointed by EC of EARLI

6. Informing the Nominated Member

The nominees will be informed about the nomination by the chair of the Scientific Committee that will invite them to attend the EARLI Conference

Winner of the EARLI Outstanding Publication Award

The winner received a plaque and a keynote lecture in the next EARLI conference

The articles that receive the second and the third place will be announced as articles receiving "a nomination for the Publication Award".
