

ERIK De CORTE Award

An Erik de Corte Award is given at each biannual EARLI conference to a young and promising scholar in the Science of Learning and Instruction.

Call for nominations

Nominations will be called biannually via the newsletter and the website. All EARLI members are invited to nominate young researchers.

Deadline

Nominations must be received by Mai 2011

Eligibility

Members nominating a particular candidate should ensure that the candidate fits the following criteria:

- Being younger than 36 on the opening day of the 14th biennial EARLI conference, 2011;
- Having at least 1 publication in one of the top 10 journals in the field of Learning and Instruction, listed in the ISI ranking;
- Active participation in research projects in the field of L&I (please specify);
- Valuable contribution to the field of Learning and Instruction (please specify);
- Being a member of EARLI.

Nomination process

1. Nominations should be submitted to earli@ped.kuleuven.be

2. The nomination should include the following materials:

- A short bio (10 lines)
- An extended CV
- A list of publications, including:
 - ✓ a copy of the first page of all published articles in internationally refereed journals or international books (or chapters),
 - ✓ the PhD thesis,
 - ✓ a letter of acceptance for articles in print (please do scan these documents if not available electronically)
- Contact information (address, email, phone number).

3. Selection Criteria:

The EARLI secretary will evaluate the materials, check the impact factors of the international journals, and make a ranking of the candidates based on national and international publications.
After this first selection of nominations, the list of nominees will be judge by a Award Committee.

The 'Erik De Corte' award can be received only once in a lifetime career.

4. Award Committee

A committee of EARLI past presidents, nominated by the EC of EARLI will analyze the quality of research activity, and will appoint the winner.

5. Informing the Nominated Member

The Secretary of EARLI will inform the candidate that he or she has been nominated for the Erik De Corte Award and will invite him/her to attend the conference

Erik De Corte award

The winner receives an award and 1000€ to use for research purposes.
