FARI I 2023 TRAVEL AWARD

The EARLI Executive Committee wishes to continue it ongoing engagement to recognise high-quality research conducted in countries that are facing financial struggles or where researchers have little access to funds.

As such, we are pleased to offer the EARLI 2023 Travel Award for participants in EARLI 2023 with an accepted presentation. Participants who are awarded a travel award will receive a one-off grant towards their travel costs (€ 1.000) and a fully waived conference fee for EARLI 2023.

The main criterion to qualify for the award is that the applicant must reside and work in a low-GDP country¹. As such, only applications from the following countries will be considered:

- African countries
- Asian countries (excluding Brunei Darussalam, Hong Kong SAR, Israel, Japan, Republic of Korea, Kuwait, Macao SAR, Qatar, Singapore, United Arab Emirates)
- South American and Caribbean countries (excluding The Bahamas, Bermuda, Cayman Islands, Puerto Rico, Sint Maarten (Dutch), Virgin Islands)
- South Pacific countries (excluding Australia, Guam, New Caledonia, New Zealand)
- and the following countries in wider European area: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Georgia, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Latvia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Turkiye and Ukraine.

This award is aimed specifically at participants in EARLI 2023 with an active role (presenting author or chair / discussant in a symposium). As such, an accepted proposal for the conference is required to qualify for this award.

A low-GDP country is determined as a country which has an annual GDP per capita lower than 71% of the GDP of the total European Union (lower than \$ 27 146,21 USD).

The following eligibility criteria apply (in order of importance).

The applicant must:

- Reside and work in a low-GDP country
- Be an **EARLI member** at the time of application
- Have an accepted proposal for EARLI 2023

Preference will be given to presenters of single papers or symposia. Equally, the review score will be used as a determining criterion: preference is given to the highest scoring proposals among the applications.

Please be advised that applications that don't meet the requirements outlined below will not be considered for the award.

Applications for the EARLI 2023 Travel Award are welcomed until the **4th of May 2023** (**midnight CEST**) and should consist of a filled-out application form at http://bit.ly/EARLI2023-AWARD supported by an uploaded list of publications and scientific achievements from 2013 – 2023 (pdf file, max. 10 MB).

All applicants will be notified of the outcome in mid May 2023.
