



JURE 2023 ELSEVIER AWARD

We are pleased to offer the **JURE 2023 Elsevier Award** for participants in JURE 2023 with an accepted presentation. Participants who are awarded with the Elsevier Award will be offered a **fully waived conference fee** for JURE and EARLI 2023, as well as an award certificate. This award is generously offered by Elsevier, publisher of the EARLI journals Learning and Instruction, and Educational Research Review.

The main criterion to qualify for the award is that the applicant must reside and work in a low-GDP country¹. As such, only applications from the following countries will be considered:

- **African countries**
- **Asian countries** (excluding Brunei Darussalam, Hong Kong SAR, Israel, Japan, Republic of Korea, Kuwait, Macao SAR, Qatar, Singapore, United Arab Emirates)
- **South American and Caribbean countries** (excluding The Bahamas, Bermuda, Cayman Islands, Puerto Rico, Sint Maarten (Dutch), Virgin Islands)
- **South Pacific countries** (excluding Australia, Guam, New Caledonia, New Zealand)
- and the following countries in **wider European area**:
Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Latvia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Türkiye and Ukraine.

A low-GDP country is determined as a country which has an annual GDP per capita lower than 71% of the GDP of the total European Union (lower than \$ 27 146,21 USD).

This award is aimed specifically at participants in JURE 2023 with an active role (presenting author). As such, an accepted proposal for the conference is required to qualify for this award.

The following eligibility criteria apply (in order of importance).

The applicant must:

- **Reside and work in a low-GDP country**
- Be an **EARLI member** at the time of application
- Have an **accepted proposal** for JURE 2023

The review score will be used as a determining criterion: preference is given to the highest scoring proposals among the applications.

Please be advised that applications that don't meet the requirements outlined below will not be considered for the award.

Applications for the JURE 2023 Elsevier Award are welcomed until the **4th of May 2023 (midnight CEST)** and should consist of a filled-out application form at <http://bit.ly/JURE2023-AWARD> supported by a short written statement why attending the JURE and EARLI 2023 conferences would benefit your academic trajectory.

All applicants will be notified of the outcome in mid May 2023.
