



## How to submit a data session?

Proposals for a data session follow a two-part structure.

1. a **short abstract** with max. 250 words and
2. an **extended summary of 600 - 1000 words** (with references), which should include:
  - 1) the topic and objective(s) of the data session,
  - 2) the relevance of the topic,
  - 3) a description of the activities planned, incl. the contribution expected from the participants,
  - 4) the potential outcomes and possible contributions emerging from the session,
  - 5) a session timeline, including sufficient time for critical discussion; timeslots of 60 or 90 minutes will be offered (note that the conference organisers will confirm duration upon finalising the program, and reviewers might request revisions to the timeline based on feasibility and quality of the proposed activities).
  - 6) an indication of how the session is designed to “walk the talk”, i.e., How do the data presentation and session activities reflect the core message/issue you wish to deliver/address? How will the participants’ experience of the data session allow them to better engage with its content?
