

## Keynote : Mônica Macedo-Rouet

### Information evaluation in a world of uncertainty: Promoting skills that are relevant to students' everyday experiences

Information evaluation is a complex cognitive process that involves the assessment of argument quality and source reliability among other skills. Students need to develop strong evaluation skills to be able to critically learn from multiple and sometimes contradictory documents they encounter in everyday life. How can educators promote such skills? This keynote will discuss different pedagogical strategies that have proven efficient in research and are promising for future educational practice.

Mônica Macedo-Rouet is a professor of educational psychology at CY Cergy Paris Université (France). She specializes in digital reading and informal learning, with a special focus on how adolescents evaluate information online and the development of educational interventions to foster evaluation skills. Her research has benefited from funding from the French National Research Agency (ANR) and the Brazilian-French Capes-Cofecub Consortium, among other sources. She has published articles in international journals such as *Computers & Education*, *Reading Research Quarterly*, and *Learning and Instruction*. Since 2022, she serves as an Associate Editor for the *Journal for the Study of Education and Development*.
