

## How to submit a workshop?

Proposals for a workshop follow a two-part structure.

- 1. A **short abstract** with max, 250 words and
- 2. an **extended summary of 600 1000 words** (with references), which should include:
- 1) the content and objective(s) of the workshop,
- 2) the relevance of the content,
- 3) a description of the activities planned, incl. the contribution expected from the participants,
- 4) the potential outcomes or possible contributions emerging from the workshop,
- 5) a session timeline, including sufficient time for critical discussion; timeslots of 60 or 90 minutes will be offered (note that the conference organisers will confirm duration upon finalising the program, and reviewers might request revisions to the timeline based on feasibility and quality of the proposed activities).
- 6) an indication of how the workshop is designed to "walk the talk", i.e., How do the workshop activities reflect the core message/issue you wish to deliver/address? How will the participants' experience of the workshop allow them to understand its content better?
